Re: National Education Union (NEU) Strike Action – arrangements for the 27th April and 2nd May 2023

I am writing to you today updating you on the next NEU strike action that is due to take place this Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May 2023. We will be opening to the following student groups:

- **All Year 11 students**
- **All Year 10 students**
- **Students with SEND** (a survey link will be sent to you separately to indicate whether your child will be attending)

Teaching for these groups will be face to face in school, although your usual teacher may not be taking the class.

Arrangements for years 7, 8 and 9:

- **Learning to take place on Teams at home** (where the staff member is not a member of the NEU. Please ask your child to log on and wait 5 minutes before assuming that their teacher is not taking the lesson. We would also be very grateful if you could remind your child that the same expectations for behaviour are expected in the online sessions and chat function as we expect in school).

All staff who are not in the NEU will be on site these days.

We apologise for the inconvenience that this may cause families. However, we must take the safety of students into account.

Should the strike days be called off or postponed after negotiations with the Government and education unions, we will inform you as soon as we can.
