### **Brilliant Club Trip to University of Manchester**

On Wednesday the 8<sup>th</sup> of February we took a group of 13 year 10 students and one year 9 students to the University of Manchester so that they could be celebrated for their incredible work on the Brilliant Club Scholars Programme.

On the programme, students work with a university researcher to give them an experience of what it's like to study at university. We call the researcher the students' PhD Tutor. The PhD tutors share their subject knowledge and passion for learning with small groups of students. This will stretch and challenge students as they develop their academic skills. Students also learn about life as a university student at Launch and Graduation Events and can ask questions of current university students. At the end of the programme students complete a final assignment of 2000 words. This is marked using the university grading system and allows students to show the progress they've made on the programme.



Students were selected for the programme based on application letters and completed their assignments on the course, "Brains in Computers: Do they have minds of their own?' This involved learning a huge amount of new material and reading a number of technical, scholarly articles in order to produce a high quality piece of work for their final assignment. We are thrilled to share that all the students completed the course, and all achieved grades at least equivalent to a 2<sup>nd</sup> class university grade. Special congratulations must go to Adam Bramford-Hale for securing a 1<sup>st</sup> for his final assignment; and to Emily Jones who spoke brilliantly at the graduation event, sharing what she had learned and gained from the programme itself.
