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#### **The Brilliant Club**

The Brilliant Club Scholars Programme will be running again this year for 14 students in the current Year 9 when they are in Year 10. On the programme, students work with a university PhD tutor on a course linked to their specialism to give them an experience of what it's like to study at university. The PhD tutors share their subject knowledge and passion for learning to help stretch and challenge students as they develop their academic skills. During the programme they will also learn about life as a university student at Launch and Graduation Events where they can ask questions of current university students. At the end of the programme students complete a final assignment of 2000 words. This is marked using the university grading system and allows students to show the progress they've made on the programme.



We have had great success with the programme before, covering subjects ranging from computer modelling the human brain to the importance of context in art installation. I have invited all students in Year 9 to apply for a place and the deadline for applications is **Monday 17<sup>th</sup> July**. I am really looking forward to the application letters I will receive.
