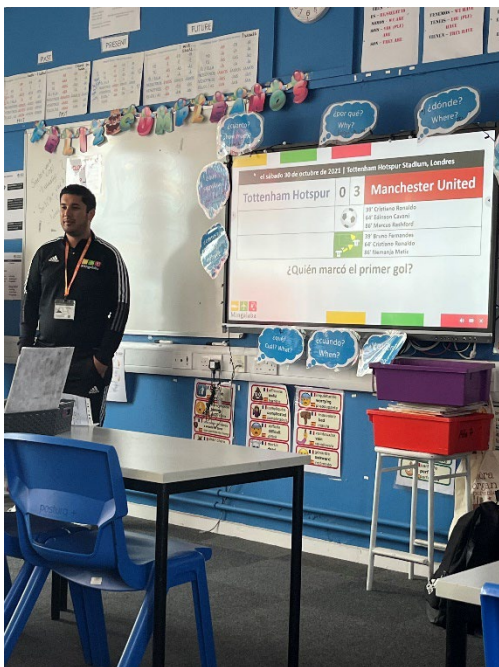
### **Year 9 visit from Steve Eaden**

They have behaved brilliantly, and as a Team we are extremely proud of them. We have told them how proud we are, but please also pass that on at home.

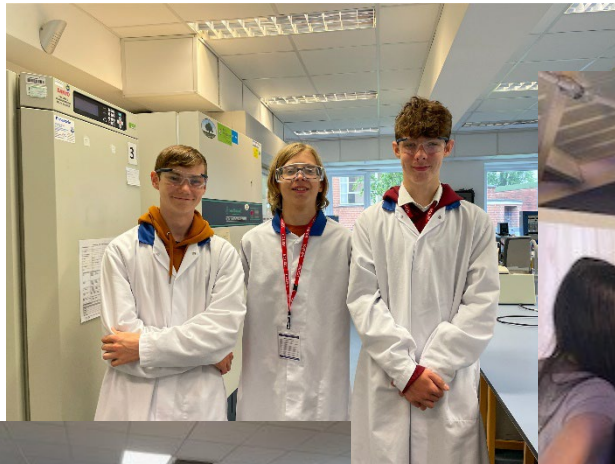
We have had so many students come up to us in the day and say thank you and how it has inspired them.
